\$400,000 in Scholarships

Computer Science, Engineering,
and Mathematics majors!

The National Science Foundation has
awarded SWTJC a grant for
scholarships in Computer Science,
Engineering, and Mathematics.
The awards are **up to \$3,000 per year.**

How do I apply?

Students in Computer Science, Engineering, and Mathematics (CSEMS) must:

- File a free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA available online at www.fafsa.ed.gov)
- Demonstrate financial need based on Federal guidelines as administered by SWTJC Financial Aid Office.
- Declare a major in a field covered by the program
- Pass all TASP areas or be TASP exempt
- Enroll in at least 12 credit hours in eligible major each fall and spring semester with an overall GPA of 3.0 or higher
- Submit a completed admissions application to SWTJC (incoming freshmen must also submit a copy of their high school transcript reflecting an overall grade average of 85)
- Be a U.S. citizen or legal resident
- Submit two letters of recommendation with at least one from an instructor or teacher
- In a 250 word essay, tell how the CSEMS scholarship will help you attain a college degree, and how you will use the degree in your professional career.

What SWTJC majors are eligible for the scholarships?

- AA in Computer Science
- AA in Engineering
- AA in Math
- AAS in Computer Information Systems

Is the scholarship renewable?

Yes, the scholarship is renewable at SWTJC for up to two years plus it may be used to pursue a bachelor's degree in an eligible major at a university. **In all cases, the total number of years is subject to NSF funding and recipient eligibility.**
